

Rules & Regulations

Classes begin on **Monday, June 24th** and continue **Monday through Friday until Friday, July 19th**. No classes will be held on **Thursday, July 4th**. The summer session will be divided into three (3) class periods of seventy (70) minutes each with a five (5) minute break between each class. The schedule is as follows:

Period	Time
1	7:30 a.m. – 8:40 a.m.
2	8:45 a.m. – 9:55 a.m.
3	10:00 a.m. – 11:10 a.m.

Classes will be held in the main building at Millbury Memorial Junior/Senior High School, and students are restricted to this area of the school.

Regular attendance is required. Students who are absent more than one (1) day must bring in a doctor's note. Students absent more than one (1) day (without a doctor's note) regardless of the situation, for any one course will not be able to receive summer school credit for that course. Vacations will not be an exception. Excessive tardiness will be counted as absenteeism. Three tardies will equal one (1) absence. Tardies are regarded as an absence if more than one-half of the class time is missed. Students are expected to wear clothing that is normally suited for high school. Footwear is required and food and beverages are not allowed in classrooms.

All the rules and regulations that are in effect during the regular school year will be followed during the summer session. **NO SMOKING** is allowed on school grounds. If transportation to and from school is by car, drivers are to adhere to applicable speed limits and exercise caution at all times. Car radios should be reduced in volume to eliminate interference with classes that are being taught in the building.

Important: Summer School is not a reward. Students are expected to work and study hard, including the completion of homework assignments, in order to pass courses.

Lavatories: Passes from classroom teachers are required for the use of lavatories during class time and should be infrequent. Students should use lavatories before classes begin.

Books: Books must be returned or payment for their replacement must be made before final grades are released.

Dismissals: Students are not to leave school grounds without the permission of the Summer School Director.

Registration: Thursday, June 20th from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and Friday, June 21st from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the High School Guidance Office.

- Registrations will not be taken over the phone.
- Registrations must be made before the start of Summer School.

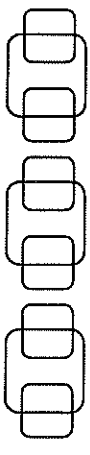

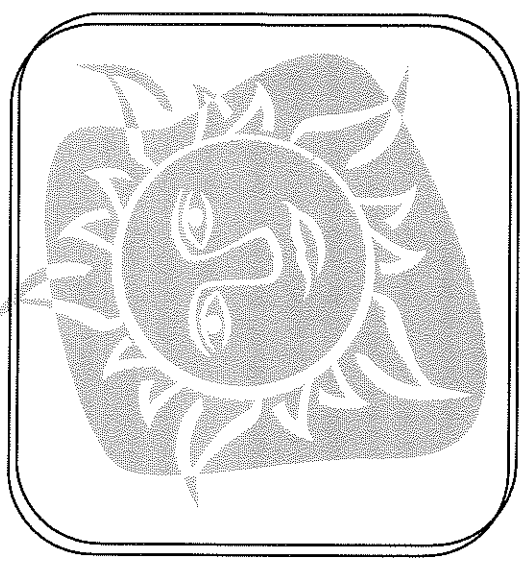

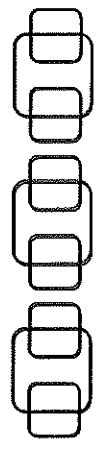
