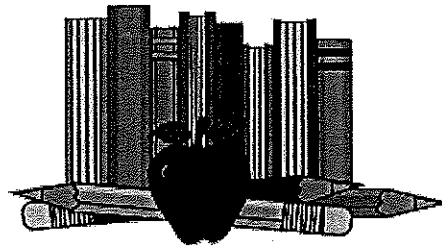

## **TUITION & PAYMENTS**

Webster Public Students grades 9 -12: \$125.00 (per course)

Non-Webster Students grades 9 -12: \$140.00 (per course)

- Payments should be made in-full at time of registration by cash or money order payable to the Town of Webster. **Personal checks will be accepted.** Do not mail cash.
- No student will be allowed to attend summer school until full payment is made at time of registration.
- **Refunds will be available only if withdrawal is prior to the first session of class (July 1st , 2019)**

## **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

Summer school attendance is of the utmost importance. In order to remain in summer school and to receive credit for the work that is completed, the following attendance procedures will be followed:

- A student may not miss more than one day of class, and all missed work must be completed.
- A student is considered tardy 1-15 minutes after a period begins.
- Two late arrivals will equal 1 absence.
- Students arriving more than 15 minutes late for a class will be marked absent for 1 day.
- If a student is asked to leave a classroom due to a behavior issue, the student will be marked absent for 1 day.
- Students enrolled in two classes are not allowed to leave the building between classes.

## **CREDIT**

Credit and grade advancement policies are different in every school system, making it the student's responsibility to check with his or her guidance department regarding the classes that need to be taken and the grade average that needs to be achieved in order to pass to the next grade. It is highly recommended that each student meet with his or her own guidance counselor before leaving school in June.

**Every student must provide the grade they need in summer school to pass for each course at time of registration.**

**Student Rules and Regulations Contract**

*Both student and parent/guardian must sign this contract before entrance to summer school.*

The Webster Regional Summer School program expects all students to act in a responsible manner. Any behavior that hinders a learning atmosphere will lead to the student being asked to leave the classroom for that day. When a student is removed from a class due to his/her behavior, it will be considered a one-day absence from that class.

- Students are allowed 1 absence per class. At the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) absence, the student will be dismissed from summer school. Two tardies will result in one absence. Marked absent after 8:15 and 10:40.
- No refunds will be allowed at any time for any reason.
- Attendance policy must be followed as mentioned on the enrollment application.

**Misbehavior will not be tolerated for any reason in the Webster Regional Summer School program. Any student who cannot behave during the three weeks of session will be dismissed from the program. Your signature below indicates you understand and agree with the statements above.**
