

Douglas High School Dance Contract

Parents/Guardians and students please read this contract carefully as your signatures indicate compliance with each of the guidelines stated below. After signing, please return to the folder in the main office or directly to the advisor of the sponsoring class/club before the next school dance in which your child plans to participate.

We understand that the standards and procedures as set forth by Douglas High School and its student handbook will be in effect at all dances, including the prom, along with the following inclusions:

1. Dress must follow the guidelines in the school handbook.
2. The Douglas Public Schools will not tolerate the use, possession, distribution, manufacture or being under the influence of any illegal drug, drug paraphernalia, or alcohol beverage in school, on school property, or at any school-related activity.
3. Students are required to act courteously and respectfully during dances. Disrespectful or sexually provocative dancing, disrespectful attitude or language to teachers and students may result in removal from the dance. Be nice to one another.
4. Any students with an absence the day of the dance may not attend the dance unless the absence is excused. Speak with administration.
5. All guests must submit a completed and approved guest verification form to the office before the dance. No guests 20 years of age or older and no middle school students will be permitted to attend any DHS dances.
6. Students must arrive within one hour of the start of the dance, unless prior administrative approval has been granted. For example, if the dance begins at 6:30pm, all students must arrive by 7:30pm.
7. Students will not be allowed to leave the dance until one hour prior to the ending time unless there is parent/guardian approval and administration is aware.
8. Bags of any kind may be subject to a search.
9. Please be reminded that all policies from the student handbook apply to school dances.

I, the undersigned, agree to abide by the guidelines stated above and realize there will be consequences if I choose not to follow them.
